ANZAC DAY – Saturday 25 April 2020

This Saturday is ANZAC Day. Commemorations this year will be very different in light of the Alert Level 4 lockdown.

New Zealanders asked to stay home for Anzac Day

The government is asking people to stay home for Anzac Day to reduce transmission of COVID-19. Anzac Day services will not go ahead this year due to the restrictions in place in response to COVID-19. This includes the National Services at Pukeahu National War Memorial Park and Atatürk Memorial.

This year, we're encouraging New Zealanders to mark Anzac Day from within your bubble instead. One way you can do this is by joining the New Zealand Defence Force and RSA's #StandAtDawn campaign. This involves standing at your letterbox, front door, lounge room, balcony, or driveway at 6am this Saturday.

This is the first time since Anzac Day services began in 1916 that New Zealanders are not able to gather nationwide to mark the anniversary. However, we will still commemorate the New Zealanders killed in war, and honour our returned servicemen and women, in other ways.


