Can I buy whiteware or computer equipment during Alert Level 4?

Yes, the Government has announced that whiteware and computer equipment can be sold at Level 4. This recognises the need for people to safely isolate, stay connected to one another and work or study from home.

In order to protect public safety, there are rules around how these things can be sold. For example, businesses can only take orders for essential non-food goods. Businesses must only take orders online or by phone, and keep storefronts shut. Goods must be delivered to people's homes without making physical contact with the buyer.

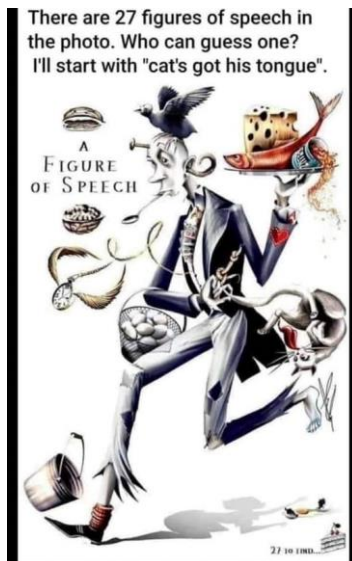


Fatigue and Stress Management Policy
