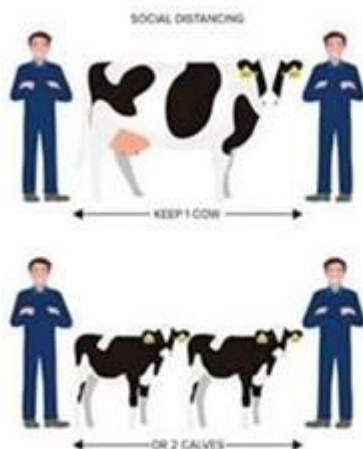


PRRA Staff Daily Update – Wednesday 15 April 2020

Weekly report to the Minister- as at Thursday 9 April 2020

Our weekly updates for the Minister have been simplified so we're giving the Minister a good picture of our operations each week. Our latest response summarised for you:

1. No issues were recorded during this week's onsite weekly mine inspection, everyone followed the recommendations regarding social distancing and hygiene.
2. No required unscheduled call out to the site over the previous week.
3. Overall the mine is stable and responses in line with trigger action response plans (TARPs) and Ventilation Officer's recommendations.
4. No security issues at the site.
5. One staff member had contracted COVID-19, but was on the mend and recovering in self-isolation. Contact tracing had been completed by health authorities. No further staff or their families are understood to have COVID-19.
6. The Agency continues to be sufficiently resourced in terms of statutory officials so that monitoring can continue.
7. Reviews of our various management plans continue to be on schedule - we aim to provide these to Worksafe by 27 April.

8. More than \$500,000 from 100 invoices has been paid to local and regional suppliers – supported by MBIE and Westpac.
9. The monthly financial statements (March 2020) were completed.

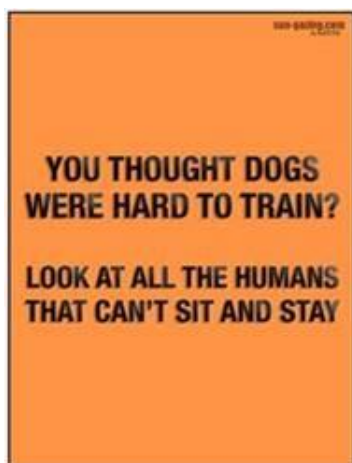
